

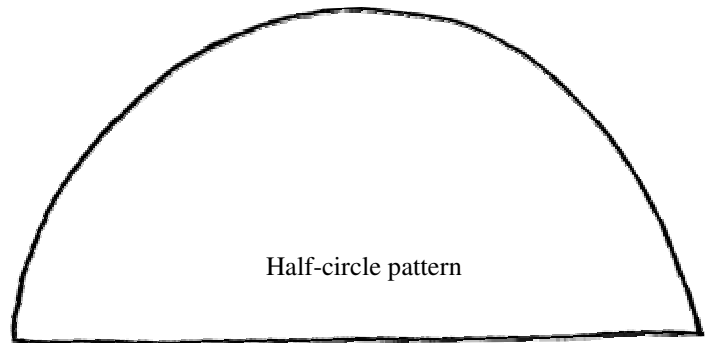
Anointed with Oil
Craft Project

Supplies per child:

- 1 half-circle paper cutout
- 1 48" piece of beige yarn
- paint brush
- newspapers to cover the tables

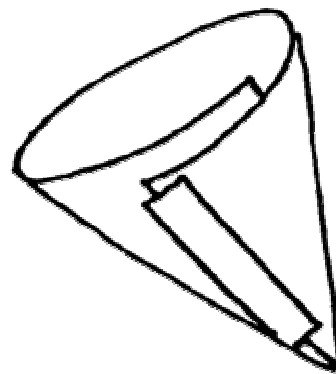
Supplies per class:

- a bowl of watered down white glue (50-50)
- wipes for clean up
- scotch tape



Instructions in class:

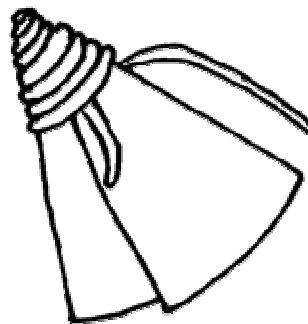
1. Have each child cut out the half circle and write his name on it
2. Turn it over and tape into a cone shape (with the name on the inside)
3. Paint the cone with the diluted glue
4. Beginning at the top, circle the yarn around and around, forming a cone. Tuck in the ends
5. Let dry until the next class.

Next class:

Cut away the excess paper



Wrap cone with yarn
