

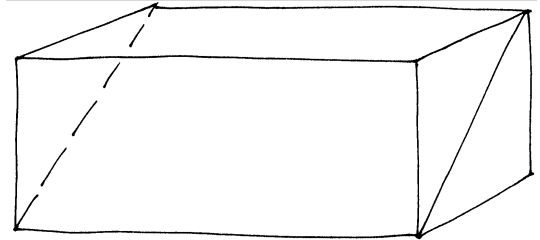
## Green Pastures Craft Project

### Supplies per child:

- 1 photo album box
- 1 brick wet foam for floral arranging
- 1 piece green felt, 11" by 14"
- glue

### Preparation before class:

1. With a serrated knife, cut the foam, long wise, diagonally, diagram 1
2. Leave one of the two pieces whole. Cut the other piece in thirds. Use one third for this craft. Set the other two thirds aside for the dark valley (L7).
3. Have the green felt cut into 11" by 14" pieces



### Instructions in class:

1. Have the kids open up their boxes. This part is made in the lid.
2. Glue one full triangle piece of foam and one of the third pieces into the long edge of the lid. See diagram 3. The glue gun works best, but white glue can be used for now. You may want to go back and re-glue the foam in later.
3. Glue the foam with the tallest side pointing up. Also, leave a little space on all sides of the lid, so the big part of the box will slide in when everything is closed up. This forms you 'hill'.
4. The green felt will cover the floor of the lid, forming the green pastures, and will go up the side of the hill and over the top, tucking down in the back. Glue the felt to the floor of the lid only, not to the hillside. We need to get into the foam later to cut away the ledge that forms the path of righteousness.

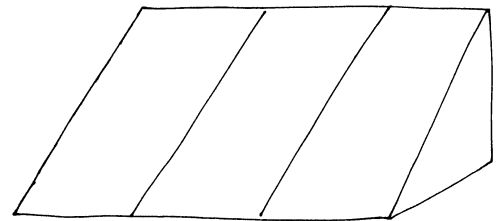

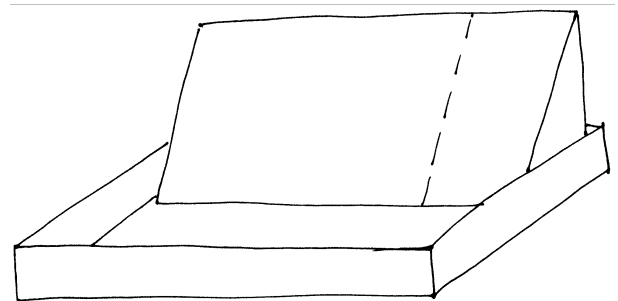

When all is done, have the kids put their shepherd and sheep back into the box and close everything up for the next lesson. This is when it is a good idea to start using the bottom of the box as the 'top' and keep the lid of the box as the 'base'. Store the boxes upside down, so the hillside stays in place. Make sure each child's name is on the new 'top' of his box.
