

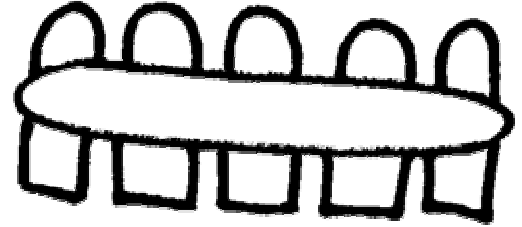
House of the Lord Craft Project

Supplies per child:

- 11 2-1/2" pop sickle sticks (these are small; purchased at a craft store)
- white or wood glue

Preparation before class: Make two 'fences' per child

1. With wire cutters, cut five sticks in half, making ten half pieces
2. Space five half pieces next to each other and glue a full piece across them, forming a 'fence'.
3. Repeat for the other five half pieces.



Make two 'fences' per child

Instructions in class:

1. Make a 'sheepfold' with the two fence pieces.
2. To make each fence stand, lay two pop sickle sticks flat at the base, one on each side.
3. Angle the two fences in the front left corner of the green pastures, leaving a small 'door' opening for the shepherd and sheep to enter the 'House of the Lord'.

* Note: A glue gun works best for making the fences stand. Depending upon the ages of the children you may have to 're-glue' the sheepfold.
