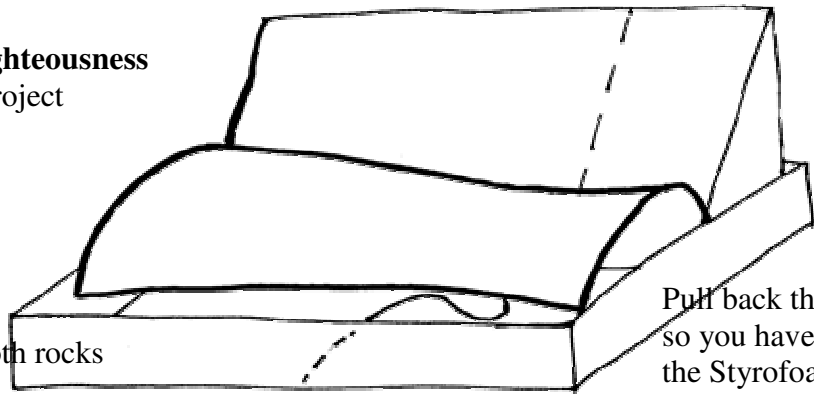


Paths of Righteousness Craft Project

Supplies per child:

Child's play box
Plastic knife
40-50 small aquarium smooth rocks
Glue

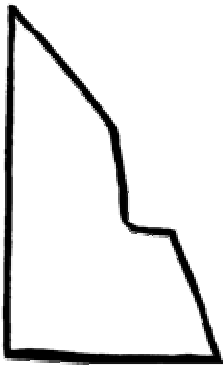


Pull back the green felt so you have access to the Styrofoam beneath.

Instructions: Note, this is a little difficult to explain, but the actual doing of it is fairly simple.

1. Pull back the green felt that covers the hillside (In the 'green pastures' craft project the felt was to be glued to the inside of the lid only, not the Styrofoam hillside.)
2. With the plastic knife, cut an 'L' shape ledge into the side of the hill, tapering it down to the valley below. Discard the scrap Styrofoam.
3. Now, glue the green felt onto the hillside, tucking it deep into the "L" shape ledge as the path curves around. Glue the extra green felt onto the back of the hill to secure it in place.
4. 'Cobblestone' the rocks into the path creating a 'path of righteousness' curving up the hillside. Glue the rocks in place.
5. Let the path 'end' in the middle of the green pastures. This makes room for the 'sheepfold' later.

* Note: you may want to take the play boxes home later and hot glue the rocks into place, as white glue doesn't adhere to rocks very well.



Side view of the "L" shape ledge cut into the Styrofoam hillside.

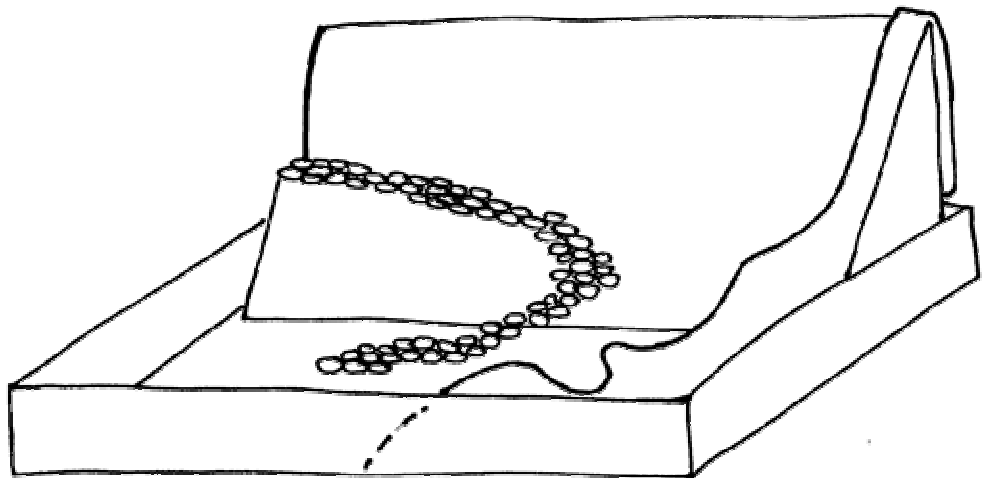


Diagram of the rock path as it winds down the hillside into the green pastures.
