

Still Waters Craft Project

Supplies per child:

Each child's 'play box'
1 piece blue art foam,
scissors
glue

Preparation before class:

1. With a pen trace the water pattern onto the art foam

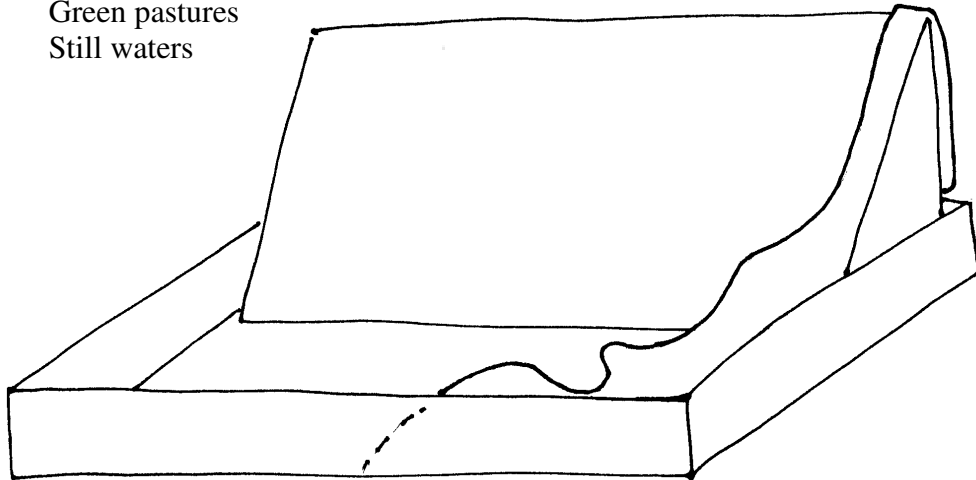
Instructions in class:

1. Have the kids open up their boxes. This part is made in the lid.
2. Cut out the water
3. Glue the water onto the right side of the hillside, so it 'flows' down and forms a wide 'river'.

Once again, have the kids put their shepherd and sheep back into the box and close everything up for the next lesson. Remember to store the boxes upside down, so the hillside stays in place.

The play box now has:

The Shepherd
The sheep
Green pastures
Still waters
